Also, listed below, are the requirements to attend a four year college or university in Montana, North Dakota and South Dakota. If your child plans on participating in athletics at a NCAA Division I school, they must fulfill the listed requirements.

2 Science  
1 additional English, Math or  
Science  
2 Social Studies  
4 years of additional courses from  
any above area or foreign language

Please note that if your student is interested in a college that isn't listed above, they need to check in the Counseling Center to see what the admissions requirements are for that specific school immediately. If your student plans on attending a Community College, Vo-tech/Trade School or the Military, the requirements for admission are a high school diploma.

If your child is college bound, whether it is a 2-year school or a 4-year school, they will need to take an entrance test. Four-year schools require the A.C.T. (American College Test) or the S.A.T. (Scholastic Aptitude Test). The ACT is a four-part, 3 hour test measuring skills in English, Math, Natural Sciences, and Social Studies and is the entrance test most colleges require.
